Getting WIN 8/10 Tablet to work on Skydemon using internal GPS

Having spent months trying to make this work on my Toshiba Encore, finally managed it...

Need to download a com port emulator that will convert the built in tablet GPS signal into one that comes from a COM port, so that Skydemon can see the feed.

Once you have loaded the software. You will need to run Localizer in admin mode
